Prison Conditions, Capital Punishment, and Deterrence argue that the quality of life in prison is likely to have a greater impact on criminal behavior than the death penalty Using state-level panel data covering the period 1950-90, we demonstrate that the death rate among prisoners (the best available proxy for prison conditions) is
